COVID PROTOCOLS

Government regulations are constantly changing. As of today, these are our protocols for our camp. We will update as we get closer. Each cabin is a cohort and will stay together and do activities together, 2 meters apart when involved with others not in their cohort. Health forms must be filled out.
